



Matchplay Procedures & Rules

Procedure for Matchplay Events (Gents & Ladies)

- (a) It is the responsibility of both sides to arrange to play the tie by the stipulated closing date.
- (b) In Exceptional Circumstances an extension to the closing date of a maximum of 3 days will be given. Request for an extension must be made to the Club Manager (not competition secretary as indicated in the fixture list) whose decision will be final.
- (c) Anyone experiencing difficulty in contacting their opponent should advise the Club Manager before the closing date of the round.
- (d) If any tie has not been completed by the due date, and neither party has contacted the Club Manager both sides will be eliminated.
- (e) If any match ends in a tie after the scheduled 18 holes, it should continue on a sudden death basis until a result is reached, Handicap allowance for sudden death holes will still apply.
- (f) If any match fails to reach completion, competitors should resume play from where play was abandoned, preferably play should be abandoned at the end of a hole.
- (g) It is the Responsibility of the competitors to ensure the results are posted on the appropriate sheet in the clubhouse immediately following the match.

Handicap Allowances

Singles Matchplay – 100% of **Course Handicap**

Foursomes Matchplay – 50% of the players combined **Course Handicap**

Please remember that your course handicap can change depending on if you are playing of the Red, Yellow or White Tees

Maximum Course Handicap Allowances

Finlayson Memorial – Maximum Course Handicap of 12

Logan Cup – Course Handicap between 13 and 24

Secretarys Cup – Maximum Course Handicap of 28
